Competition Waters:

- Lake Oconee

Practice:

- Competition waters are open for practice until 5:30 p.m. March 20.
- The purchasing of, or bartering for, information or the hiring of fishing guide services is not permitted after March 11.
- Review rule 4 for complete details.

Boat Operation:

- Contestants are not permitted to drive the boat when the combustion engine is running. Coaches will arrange boat captains to supply and drive boats for their teams. Coaches may also serve as boat captains. Contestants may operate the trolling motor. Coaches and boat captains may provide information about locating and catching fish, but are not permitted to fish on competition days.

Catch and Size Limit:

- Five bass per team; minimum 14 inches on largemouth, smallmouth and spotted bass.

License Requirement:

- A Georgia fishing license is required for students 16 and older. Click [here](#) to purchase.

Format:

- The GHSA Cup is open to only GHSA member schools. It is a kickoff tournament for full GHSA bass fishing competition starting with the 2020-2021 school year.

Rules:

- The GHSA Cup will operate under the same rules as outlined for the 2020-2021 GHSA Regionals and State Championship. Click [here](#) for the complete set of rules. (Exception: Filing eligibility for this one event is waived.)
