Weigh-in begins daily: 1:30p.m. Tournament Director Randy Sullivan 580-716-4261 randy@federationangler.com	Required Items and Safety EquipmentIt is the responsibility of participants to have ALL required state and federal safety equipment on board and ALL permits, licenses, passes or stamps, required.At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.Anglers 16 years old or older, (over 15 in Iowa only waters) are required to have a valid fishing license/ permit, if
		applicable by law.
Fish Limits Largemouth & Smallmouth bass 14" inches and over. Anglers are allowed to weigh a limit of three (3) fish per team unless otherwise required by law or tournament officials. Fish presented which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented that is determined to be non-releasable. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limits. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre- tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
