Fish Limits12" Spotted Bass, 15" Largemouth, 18"Smallmouth - Only 1 SmallmouthAnglers are allowed to weigh a limit of five(5) fish per team unless otherwise requiredby law or tournament officials.Fish presented which fails to measure theofficial length limits shall accrue penaltiesat the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ouncededuction will be made for each fishpresented that is determined to benon-releasable.
