Live wells must be empty.Anglers 16 years old or older, (over 15 in Iowa only waters) are required to have a valid fishing license/ permit, if applicable by law.
Fish LimitsLarge & Smallmouth bass 14" and over.Anglers are allowed to weigh a limit of three(3) fish per team unless otherwise requiredby law or tournament officials.Fish presented which fails to measure theofficial length limits shall accrue penalties atthe rate of one (1) pound for each non-legalfish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ouncededuction will be made for each fishpresented that is determined to benon-releasable.
