- Each student angler can access our Online education program at Faculty of Fishing.com. A vast wealth of fishing knowledge is at your fingertips your free, each angler simply needs to contact the Federation National Office for an access code. (580-765-9031)
- All SAF State Championships, Open Challenge events and MLF Opens are NO entry fee events and awards are in the form of scholarships, prizes and trophies, no cash.
- The SAF High School Fishing World Finals & National Championship combined event offers MILLIONS in scholarship each year. It is high school fishing’s premier event. You must have a 2.0 GPA before prizes can be released. You can still fish the event but awards will be held as a incentive to get grades up! The World Finals portion is open to all SAF members, you must qualify for the National Championship portion.
- Advancement from all SAF State Championships, SAF or MLF Open events or any SAF sanctioned trail to a true National Championship!
- Pursuant to Federal law under the Youth Safe Sports Act of 2017 (applies not only to fish but any organized youth sport, Cheer, Church Camp, Bball, etc.) a minor CANNOT be alone with an adult during an organized youth event. They must be within observable distance of a 3rd person at all times, there is NO exception for a parent/child in the law applies ONLY during an **organized YOUTH** event) Therefore there MUST be 3 to a boat in all organized YOUTH fishing events.

COST – NO cost to the school and only \$25 per student angler. The \$25 yearly individual membership allows each SAF member to fish ANY and ALL SAF events for free! It includes member benefits of both, The Bass Federation’s Student Angler Federation, (SAF) and MLF, eight issues of MLFs electronic magazine, access to Facultyoffishing.com online training courses if desired, discounts on the members-only store and TBF’s industry leading comprehensive insurance policy!

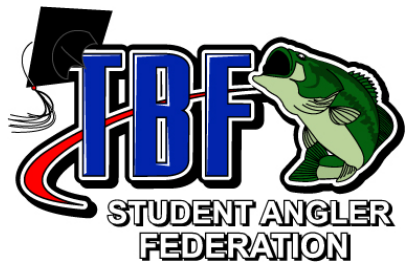

Go to highschoolfishing.org; Enter a Tournament, enter your team in your state championship, an SAF Open Event or the 13th annual 2022 High School Fishing World Finals! Not already an SAF member? Enter a tournament and pay your \$25 yearly membership at the same time.
