Competition Waters:

- West Point Lake

Practice:

- Competition waters are open for practice until 5:00p.m. on March 18
- The purchasing of, or bartering for, information or the hiring of fishing guide services will not be permitted after March 8.

Boat Operation:

- Contestants are not permitted to drive the boat when the combustion engine is in operation. Each boat will be driven by a coach or volunteer driver. Contestants may operate the trolling motor. Coaches and volunteers may provide assistance, including information about locating and catching fish, but are not permitted to fish.

Catch & Size Limit:

- Five bass per team; minimum 14 inches on largemouth and 12 on spotted bass.

License Requirement:

- A Valid GA fishing license is required for students 16 and older. Click [here](#) to purchase.

Format:

- Each GHSA approved school may enter up to six boats in each regional competition. The top 15 boats from each regional advance to the state Championship. One additional boat will advance from each regional for every 10 boats that compete over a minimum of 100 boats in the regional. Boats advance from the first event in which they qualified. If a boat has already qualified for the state championship, the next eligible boat will advance.

Rules:

- GHSA, the Student Angler Federation (SAF) and MLF expect strict adherence to the following rules by all contestants. GHSA, SAF and MLF also recommend the use of non-puncturing culling clips for marking fish and livewell additives to help promote the healthy release of bass.
