# **Competition Waters:**

Green River Lake

#### **Practice:**

- Competition waters are open for practice until 5:30 p.m. April 29.
- The purchasing of, or bartering for, information or the hiring of fishing guide services will not be permitted after April 14.

## **Boat Operation:**

Contestants are not permitted to drive the boat when the combustion
engine is in operation. Each boat will be driven by a coach or volunteer
driver. Contestants may operate the trolling motor. Coaches and
volunteers may provide assistance, including information about
locating and catching fish, but are not permitted to fish.

## **Catch and Size Limit:**

• Five bass per team; minimum 12" largemouth, smallmouth & spotted bass.

#### **License Requirement:**

• A Kentucky fishing license is required for students 16 and older. Click here to purchase.

#### **Format:**

 A minimum of 16 boats will advance to the KHSAA State Championship from each region. Additional boats will advance based on the process outlined in the KHSAA rules clinic.
