Live wells must be empty.</p> <p>Anglers are required to have a valid AL, MS or TN Fishing License / permit, if applicable by law. Check all three states for reciprocal agreements when fishing in any of these three states waters.</p>
<p align="center"><b><u>Fish Limits</u></b></p> <p>Large, smallmouth, and spotted Bass 15" inches and over.</p> <p>Anglers are allowed to weigh a limit of three (3) fish per team unless otherwise required by law or tournament officials.</p> <p>Fish presented which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented that is determined to be non-releasable.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Tournament Directors</u></b></p> <p>Randy Sullivan          580-716-4261</p> <p align="center"><b><u>Host Hotels</u></b></p> <p align="center"><a href="#">See lodging list attached</a></p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Boundaries</u></b></p> <p>Lake Pickwick and Wilson only. Locking is into Wilson only. Alabama, Mississippi &amp; Tennessee water are involved. Check for reciprocal licenses. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limits. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.</p>
