#### **Competition Waters:**

- Lake Cumberland

#### **Practice:**

- Competition waters are open for practice until 5:30 p.m. April 25.
- The purchasing of, or bartering for, information or the hiring of fishing guide services will not be permitted after April 11.

#### **Boat Operation:**

- Contestants are not permitted to drive the boat when the combustion engine is in operation during tournament hours. Each boat will be driven by a coach or volunteer driver. Contestants may operate the trolling motor. Coaches and volunteers may provide assistance, including information about locating and catching fish, but are not permitted to fish.

#### **Catch and Size Limit:**

- Five bass per team; 12" Spotted Bass, 15" Largemouth and 18" smallmouth

#### **License Requirement:**

- A Kentucky fishing license is required for students 16 and older. Click [here](#) to purchase.

#### **Format:**

- For the co-ed competition, a minimum of 16 boats will advance to the KHSAA State Championship from each region with the remaining 26 boats qualifying based on the ratio of boats entering the water at the regional championship to the number of total boats in all of the regions.
- For the All-female Division competition, the number of qualifying boats will advance to the KHSAA State Championship based on the ratio of boats entering the water at the regional championship to the number of total boats in all of the regions.

#### **Rules:**

- KHSAA, the Student Angler Federation and MLF expect strict adherence to the following rules by all contestants. KHSAA, SAF and MLF also recommend the use of livewell additives to help promote the healthy release of bass.
